TRINITY

Trilogy – Trinitarianism

Places in the Bible where it shows that God the Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Ghost are the same being.

The [Trinity](#) is the doctrine that there is one God who manifests Himself as three distinct, simultaneous persons. The Trinity does not assert that there are three gods, but only one. This is important because many groups who oppose orthodoxy, will accuse Trinitarians of believing in three gods. But this is not so. The doctrine of the Trinity is that there is one God in three persons.

The Christian doctrine of the **Trinity** teaches the unity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit as three persons in one Godhead.

The **Trinity** is the Christian doctrine that God is one Being Who exists, simultaneously and eternally, as a mutual indwelling of three persons (not to be confused by "person"): the Father, the Son (incarnate as Jesus of Nazareth), and the Holy Spirit. Since the 4th century, in both Eastern Christianity and Western Christianity, this doctrine has been stated as "three persons in one God," all three of whom, as distinct and co-eternal persons, are of one indivisible Divine essence, a simple being.

Triune: We believe in one Triune God, who is Creator of all (Deuteronomy 6:4; Colossians 1:16), eternally existing in three distinct Persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (2 Corinthians 13:14), yet one in being, essence, power and glory, having the same attributes and perfections (John 10:30).

TRITHEISM

Places in the bible where it shows that God the father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Ghost are three separate and distinct beings

The Biblical basis of the belief in the Godhead of the Church Of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and several other Christian churches.

Tritheism is the belief that there are three distinct, powerful gods, who form a triad.

Matthew 3:

16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Stephen saw Christ standing on the right hand of God the Father.

Acts 7:

55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.

Christ testifies that the Father sent Him.

John 7:33

33: Then said Jesus unto them, Yet a little while am I with you, and then I go unto him that sent me.

John 8:16-19

But if I do judge, my decisions are right, because I am not alone. I stand with the Father, who sent me. In your own Law it is written that the testimony of two men is valid. I am one who testifies for myself; my other witness is the Father, who sent me." Then they asked him, "Where is your father?" "You do not know me or my Father," Jesus replied. "If you knew me, you would know my Father also."

John 10:36-38

36: Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

37: If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.

38: But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.

God exalted Christ and gave Christ the Holy Ghost

30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.

32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.

Christ is the Only Begotten Son of God

3: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ.

4: I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ;

Apostles heard the voice of the Father while Christ was still on the earth

Matthew 17:1-5

Peter, James, and John testify that they heard the Father's voice.

1 John 1:1-3

1: That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

2: (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

3: That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

Christ was sent to do the will of His Father

Luke 2:49

49: And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?

John 4:34

34: Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.

John 5:19-21

The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise. For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth; and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel. For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the son quickeneth whom he will".

28: *Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for my Father is greater than I.*

Christ is our advocate With the Father

1 John 2:1

1: My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

2: And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.

Comparison of Wife to Husband to Christ to God being one relationship

1 Cor 11

Wife is to husband as husband is to Christ as Christ is to God

Comparison of Apostles to Christ to God being one relationship

John 17:11

And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are.

John 17:18

18: As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

30: I and my Father are one.

2 John 1:9-11

9: Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.

10: If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed:

11: For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds.

Holy Ghost will teach you about Christ

John 16: 13-14

13: Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

14: He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

If you hate Christ you hate the Father

23: He that hateth me hateth my Father also.
